Aluminum Foil Scissors



Step One: Grab your scissors and cut 5 equal length strips of foil paper.





Step Two: Use your hands to begin to roll the 5 strips of aluminum foil into long strands.



Step Three: Grab another piece of Aluminum foil and form a ball.








Step Four: Grab more aluminum foil and add another layer to the circle you just formed. Now create a strip that attaches to the center of your circle.



Step Five: Grab the 5 strands of aluminum foil you made. Place them on the strip that is attached to the circle and roll the strip up.



Step Six: Separate the legs. Then grab your scissors and cut the front 2 strands to make a jaw.



Step Seven: Pinch the legs to form a high bend.





Step Eight: Grab more aluminum foil and give your legs more length.

And now you have created your own Louise Bourgeois inspired spider!
