SUPPLIES NEEDED:

8 SHEETS OF COLORED
PAPER/CONSTRUCTION

PAPER

PENCIL

SCISSORS

GLUE

TAPE

BLACK PAINT

PAINT BRUSH



**FIRST STEP
GRAB 4 DIFFERENT
COLORED SHEETS.
TAPE THEM TOGETHER BY
RUNNING TAPE
DIAGONALLY & VERTICALLY
DOWN THE MIDDLE.**



**STEP TWO
GRAB 4 SHEETS OF
COLORED PAPER & USING
YOUR PENCIL TRACE YOUR
HAND ON EACH.**



STEP THREE
CUT EACH OF THE HANDS
YOU TRACED.



STEP FOUR
GLUE A HAND CUT OUT
INTO THE MIDDLE OF A
COLORED SQUARE. REPEAT
THE PROCESS ON EACH
SQUARE.



STEP FIVE
POUR BLACK PAINT INTO
THE PALM OF YOUR
HANDS.



STEP SIX
USING A PAINT BRUSH
SPREAD THE BLACK PAINT
ACROSS YOUR HAND.
MAKE SURE TO
COMPLETELY COVER YOUR
HAND.



STEP SEVEN
FIRMLY PRESS YOUR HAND
ONTO THE PAPER TO
CREATE A HAND PRINT.
REPEAT THE PROCESS.
