


Step One: Draw 2 circles across from each other and connect them.





Step Two: Draw a rectangle at an angle on the top circle. Then draw a semi circle on the bottom circle.






Step Three: Grab your white paint and brushes. Paint the whole banana white and let dry.




Step Four: Grab your yellow paint. Paint the whole banana yellow and let dry.





Step Five: Grab your pencil and mark where you want to add shading for the banana.



Step Six: Grab your black paint and fill in the marks you created earlier.
