**Andy Warhol was an American artist, film director, and producer who was a leading figure in the visual art movement known as pop art.**



**His works explore the relationship between artistic expression, advertising, and celebrity culture that flourished by the 1960s, and span a variety of media, including painting, silkscreening, photography, film, and sculpture.**

# Supplies Needed:

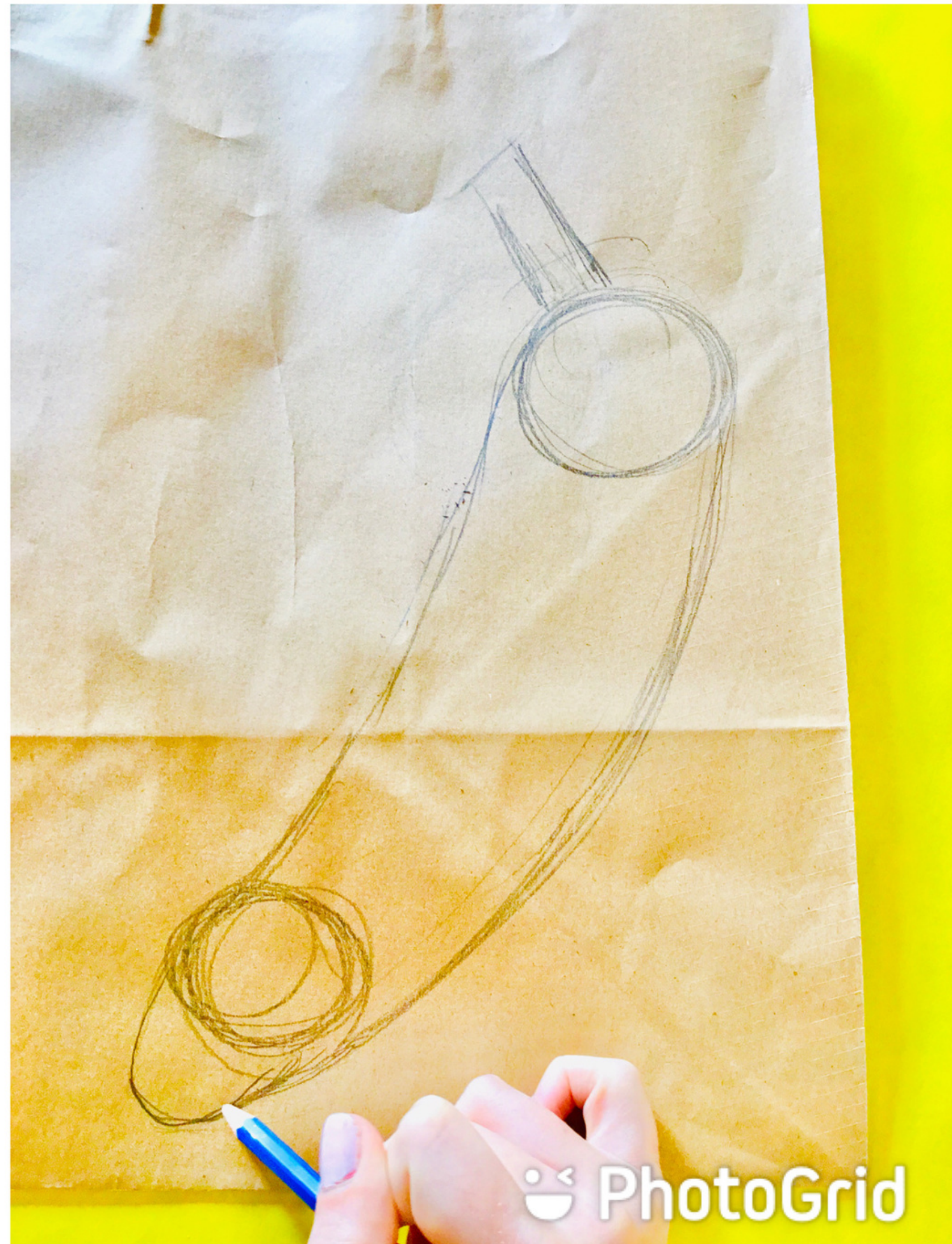
Paper Bag  
Paint Brushes  
Yellow Paint  
Black Paint  
White Paint  
Pencil



**Step One:**  
**Draw 2 circles across from each other and connect them.**



**Step Two:**  
**Draw a rectangle at an angle on the top circle. Then draw a semi circle on the bottom circle.**



**Step Three:**  
**Grab your white paint and brushes. Paint the whole banana white and let dry.**



**Step Four:**  
**Grab your yellow paint. Paint the whole banana yellow and let dry.**





**Step Five:**  
**Grab your pencil and mark where you want to add shading for the banana.**



**Step Six:**  
**Grab your black paint and fill in**  
**the marks you created earlier.**



**You have now created your own Andy Warhol inspired tote bag!**
